The Services Export Promotion Council has appointed Vipin Vohra, Chairman of Continental Carriers Pvt. Ltd., as its Vice-Chairperson. He will work with industry and government stakeholders to strengthen India's services exports.



The Services Export Promotion Council (SEPC), set up by the Ministry of Commerce and Industry, Government of India, has nominated Vipin Vohra, Chairman of Continental Carriers Pvt. Ltd. (CCPL), as its Vice-Chairperson. SEPC works to promote India's services exports and facilitates engagement between service sector stakeholders and the Government on policy and trade-related matters.

In his new role, Vohra will work with the Council, industry stakeholders and trade forums to identify key issues affecting services exports and take them up with the relevant ministries and government authorities. He will also focus on strengthening collaboration between industry and the Government to support the growth of India's services sector.
